MEMORANDUM OF ASSOCIATION

[Pursuant to rule 19(2) the Companies (Incorporation) Rules, 2014]

OF

INTERNATIONAL COUNCIL FOR SOCIAL AND SCIENTIFIC RESEARCH

1. The name of the company is “**INTERNATIONAL COUNCIL FOR SOCIAL AND SCIENTIFIC RESEARCH**”.
2. The registered office of the company will be situated in New Delhi.
3. The objects for which the company is established are:

(A) THE MAIN OBJECTS TO BE PURSUED BY THE COMPANY ON ITS INCORPORATION ARE -

1. To establish and develop Scientific & Technological Research like as Biotechnology, Genetics, Nuclear Physics, Space Research, Modern Physics and Optical & Thermal field Research.
2. Provide Social & Scientific Services For Research & Development to hold, arrange and organize meeting, Research, Survey & Study Report, lectures, talks, discussions, seminars, the artistic performances and other cultural activities, sports and games etc.
3. To establish and develop Conservation of Environment, Study & Research of Environmental Conditions and to aware people about that.
4. Providing necessary assistance during natural calamities and such other assistance as may be required from time to time.
5. To establish, Cultural and Social Institutions etc.
6. To establish centers for employment generation.
7. To establish, develop, maintain and grant aid in cash or in kind to hospitals, medical schools, medical colleges, nursing institutions, dispensaries, maternity homes, child welfare centers and/or such other similar charitable institutions in India for the benefit and use of the general public.
8. Advancement and Propagation of Education Work in the form of establishment, maintenance and support of school, Colleges, Universities, Pathashalas, Madarsa and other educational institutions.
9. To establish a Health program (Especially for AIDS, TB, LIPROCY Control etc.)
10. To establish and develop institutions for the physically handicapped and disabled or mentally retarded persons and to provide them education, food, clothing or other help.
11. To establish a program for women empowerment like as leadership development of women.

12. To establish, maintain or grant aid to homes for the aged, orphanages or other establishments for the relief and help to the poor, needy and destitute people, orphans, widows and aged persons.
13. No objects of the Company will be carried out without obtaining prior approval / NOC from concerned authority whenever required.
14. None of the objects of the Company will be carried out on commercial basis.

(B) THE OBJECTS INCIDENTAL OR ANCILLARY ATTAINMENT OF THE AFORESAID MAIN OBJECTS ARE :-

1. To recruit trained manpower and source trainers and experts to ensure adequate participation by them in achieving the objects of the Company.
2. To enter into any arrangements with any Government(s) or authorities whether Central, State, municipal, local or any other person, that may seem conducive to the objects of the Company.
3. To purchase, take on lease or in exchange, hire or otherwise acquire any movable or immovable property, and in particular any land, building, workshops, factories, laboratories, machinery, plant apparatus, appliances, trades, trademarks, licenses, permits, intellectual property rights (IPRs), and any rights or privileges necessary or convenient for the purpose of meeting the objects of the Company.
4. To collect fee including membership fee, service charges, consultancy charge, compensations or such other monies as may be required in due course of functioning of the Company and in furtherance of its objects.
5. To hold shares in any other company or association, with objects similar to its own and to have branches all over India and elsewhere.
6. To establish, support, or aid in the establishment of associations, institutions, funds and trusts as may be required in furtherance of the objects of the Company.
7. To work with global consultants, Sector associations as well as experts from national and international agencies associated with research and development, training, skill development, course accreditation or other required specializations in the Sector.
8. To liaise and collaborate with various associations in the Sector or otherwise by suitable means (memorandum of understanding, collaboration agreements, partnering arrangements and others) for course content development, arrangement of apprenticeships within the Sector.
9. To organize and participate in seminars, conferences, fairs related to the objects of the Company and to compile, collate, edit and publish technical reports and papers related to the objects of the Company.
10. To participate in the affiliation, accreditation, examination and certification.
11. To facilitate and assist the Appropriate Governmental Authority and National Skill Development Corporation (NSDC) in strengthening the existing vocational education system for skill development in the Sector and to collaborate in upgrading vocational training system in the Sector, in line with requirements to achieve global standards in manpower productivity.
12. To make provision to advance the cause of, and impart nursery, primary, secondary, higher, commercial, industrial, technical, physical and all or any other type or kind of education.
13. To employ/engage/take on deputation from other organizations including Appropriate Governmental Authority / NSDC, temporarily or in regular employment, such professionals, skilled workers, technical advisors, consultants, managers or other persons in order to provide valuable inputs to further the objects of the National Skill Development Policy, 2009, issued by the Ministry of Labour

and that of the Company and to pay them such remuneration as may be considered expedient and commensurate with the Sector norms.




14. To establish, maintain take over management, administer or run any institutions, colleges, university engaged in the imparting of education to student's up to any level that may be found necessary and/or desirable.
15. To devise and suggest suitable model(s) to the NSDC / Appropriate Governmental Authority, for establishment, development and operation of new sector skill centers, their governance, accreditation, inter-centre linkages.
16. To accept grants, donations, assistance from public bodies, corporations, companies or persons or trusts and foundations for the purposes of achieving the objects of the Company and to manage efficient, effective and permissible fund flow and fund utilization in consonance with the objects stated herein.
17. To borrow or raise such moneys within India as may be required by the Company for fulfilling its objects, by the issue of bills of exchange, promissory notes or other obligations or securities of the Company, or by mortgage / pledge / hypothecation of all or any part of the property of the Company subject to such conditions as imposed by the Board in consonance with NSDC/ Appropriate Governmental Authority.
18. To pay salary/wages/fee including consultancy, retainer-ship fee, sitting fee or rent and incur all other expenses needed in fulfillment of the objects of the Company.
19. Establishment, maintenance and support of libraries, museums and reading rooms and distribution of books etc., for advancement of education and knowledge in general.
20. To construct, erect, develop, improve, or alter and keep in repair any building acquired or used by or for the Company and to pull down or demolish or dispose off any building not so required or for renovation and reconstruction and to maintain, deal with, manage, control and administer the same.
21. To pay all expenses, preliminary or incidental to the formation of the Company and its registration.
22. To run research institutions, educational & training institutions, training of trainers establishment and any other establishment as may be required in due course of functioning of the Company and in furtherance of its objects, and publish books, reports journals, magazines, newspapers, periodicals, thesis, researches, writings, discoveries, documents, news and information.
23. To appoint legal and technical advisers (not being Members), bankers for the Company and to pay the necessary expenses for the same.
24. To draw, make accept, endorse, discount, execute and issue cheques, promissory notes, hundies, bills of lading, railway receipt and other negotiable instruments of all description in connection with the Company's business.
25. To do all such other lawful things as may be incidental to or conducive to the attainment of the above objects.

Provided that the Company shall not support with its funds or Endeavour to impose on or procure to be observed by its members or others, any regulation or restriction which, if an object of the company would make it a Trade Union.

4. The objects of the company extend to the whole of India.
5. (i) The profits, if any, or other income and property of the company, when so ever derived, shall be applied, solely for the promotion of its objects as set forth in this memorandum.

- (ii) No portion of the profits, other income or property aforesaid shall be paid or transferred, directly or indirectly, by way of dividend, bonus or otherwise by way of profit, to persons who, at any time are, or have been, members of the company or to any one or more of them or to any persons claiming through any one or more of them.
 - (iii) No remuneration or other benefit in money or money's worth shall be given by the company to any of its members, whether officers or members of the company or not, except payment of out-of-pocket expenses, reasonable and proper interest on money lent, or reasonable and proper rent on premises let to the company.
 - (iv) Nothing in this clause shall prevent the payment by the company in good faith of prudent remuneration to any of its officers or servants (not being members) or to any other person (not being member), in return for any services actually rendered to the company.
 - (v) Nothing in clauses (iii) and (iv) shall prevent the payment by the company in good faith of prudent remuneration to any of its members in return for any services (not being services of a kind which are required to be rendered by a member), actually rendered to the company;
- 6.** No alteration shall be made to this memorandum of association or to the articles of association of the company which are for the time being in force, unless the alteration has been previously submitted to and approved by the Registrar.
- 7.** The liability of the members is limited.
- 8.** The share capital of the company will consist of Rs.1,00,000 (One Lakh Only) divided into 10,000 (Ten Thousands) shares of rupees 10 /- (Ten Rupees) each.
- 9.** **(1)** True accounts shall be kept of all sums of money received and expended by the company and the matters in respect of which such receipts and expenditure take place, and of the property, credits and liabilities of the company; and, subject to any reasonable restrictions as to the time and manner of inspecting the same that may be imposed in accordance with the regulations of the company for the time being in force, the accounts shall be open to the inspection of the members.
- (2)** Once at least in every year, the accounts of the company shall be examined and the correctness of the balance-sheet and the income and expenditure account ascertained by one or more properly qualified auditor or auditors.
- 10.** If upon a winding up or dissolution of the company, there remains, after the satisfaction of all the debts and liabilities, any property whatsoever, the same shall not be distributed amongst the members of the company but shall be given or transferred to such other company having objects similar to the objects of this company, subject to such conditions as the Tribunal may impose, or may be sold and proceeds thereof credited to the Rehabilitation and Insolvency Fund formed under section 269 of the Act.
- 11.** The Company can be amalgamated only with another company registered under section 8 of the Act and having similar objects.
